Roma 2024 EAC Volunteers program is open

Application form online until 31st December

Humangest is the Official HR Supplier of the project

Rome, August 4, 2023 - A unique opportunity to experience up close the atmosphere of a major international sporting event and contribute to its success. The Roma 2024 European Athletics Championships are now accepting volunteers' applications, who can participate in an operational role during the event scheduled from June 7 to June 12 next year.

The EuroRoma 2024 Foundation (LOC) launches the "Rome 2024 Volunteers" project with the support of Humangest, the Employment Agency of SGB Humangest Holding, with exclusively Italian capital, specialized in business consulting services, in the search, selection, training and management of Human Resources, gamification, outsourcing, logistics, payroll, and executive search. The collaboration stems from the shared values of sports, such as respect, loyalty, mutual trust, and fair competition, which are essential in athletics and also for Humangest's activities.

"We can finally rally young athletics enthusiasts and the entire community to participate in this exciting adventure. Rome 2024 Volunteers represents a central project in the vision that the Foundation has set for itself, to develop themes of sustainability, innovation, and well-being. The volunteers will contribute to the success of the great event and will be the first ambassadors of athletics values in the city and at all competition venues," says Paolo Carito, General Director of the EuroRoma 2024 Foundation.

"We are honored to participate as the Official HR Supplier at the Roma 2024 European Athletics Championships, the most important sports event at the national level scheduled for the next year. This allows us to work, together with the Local Organizing Committee, on a meaningful project like 'Rome 2024 Volunteers', which conveys values we share, such as inclusion and collaboration," adds Barbara Garofoli, CEO of Humangest. *"We believe in young people and their talent. The opportunity to take part in such a prestigious event will give many boys and girls the chance to grow personally and professionally, developing skills that are valuable even in the world of work."*

The EuroRoma 2024 Foundation has assigned a name - "Rome 2024 Volunteers" - and designed a logo specifically dedicated to the project, aiming to involve volunteers to promote the inclusion and integration of all individuals interested in getting closer to the world of athletics. In this way, volunteers will also have the opportunity to experience the "behind the scenes" of the sports event, enriching their personal and professional development.

The "Rome 2024 Volunteers" program aims to empower the younger generations, directly involving secondary schools, universities in Rome, and the Lazio Region in the recruitment campaign. Equally important will be the contribution of local athletic associations, whose members will provide specific skills and a passion for the discipline during the event.

The selected volunteers, over 1,000 in number, will receive exclusive benefits, including access to the sports competitions scheduled during the Roma 2024 European Athletics Championships, attendance at specific training sessions organized by Humangest and EuroRoma 2024, an official uniform assigned to each volunteer, and participation in the closing party of the Championships.

After the selection phase, the volunteers will undergo an initial general training course, both online and in person, and will then be assigned to specific functional areas related to the event's organization: Accreditation, Spectator Services, Competitions, Protocol and Ceremonies, Media-Communication, Medical-Anti-doping Area, Hotels, Transport, Venue, Hospitality, Sponsor-Marketing. Some of the volunteers will also be stationed throughout the city at strategic locations, providing information and tourist-cultural services leading up to the Championships.

All the necessary information for submitting the application form to "Rome 2024 Volunteers" is available on the official website of the event (www.roma2024.eu/volontari) and on Humangest website (www.humangest.it).

Requirements for participation:

- a) Have turned 18 years old by June 6, 2024, which is the start date of Rome 2024 (or be of legal age at the beginning of the volunteering experience for collateral activities).
- b) Be Italian citizens with knowledge of the English language or citizens of other nationalities with a basic level of English and Italian language proficiency.
- c) Enjoy civil and political rights.
- d) Have no criminal convictions, not be under guardianship, and not be subject to preventive measures or other measures.
- e) Ensure a minimum availability to participate in the event based on the dates of the official calendar and/or collateral events.
